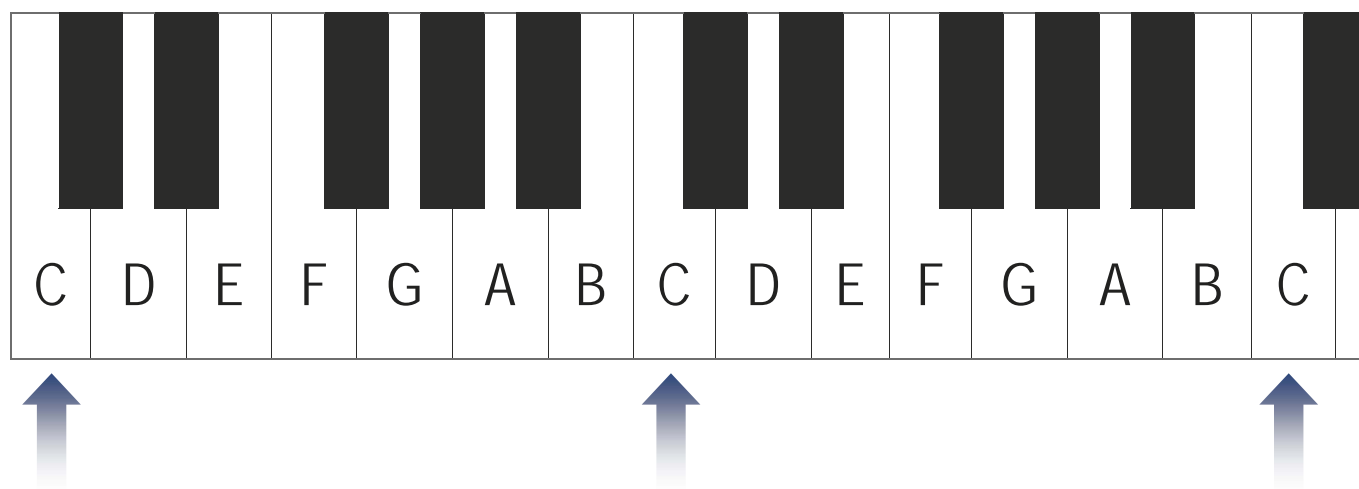


Letters in Music



The notes in music get named with letters. We only use 7 letters: A, B, C, D, E, F, & G. After that, we start over at "A".

On the piano, we use the black notes to help us find the letters. For example, wherever there is a group of 2 black notes, the white note just to the left is "C".
